

Rules of conduct

During your stay, and for all the people who will follow you, we thank you in advance not to smoke inside the tiny house and to respect the few points below.

Take off your shoes before entering the tiny house!
Thank you for using the wooden board when cooking.

Using the dry toilet

It's very easy ! After each visit, a sufficient amount of sawdust is used to cover all the liquid and feces.

No need to put too much!

When the bucket is full, empty it in the compost located behind the dry toilet.

After emptying, the bucket is cleaned with water before returning to the toilet.

Sawdust bags are available behind the dry toilet.

Sorting of waste A recycling bin is available. You can empty it in our recycling bin when you leave. In the country it is easy to compost. We put at your disposal a compost bin on the work plan of the kitchen. When full, empty it into the compost pile behind the dry toilet. Wood stove If you are not familiar with wood stoves, be careful! Ask us for a hand. In the dry season, the dangers of fire are everywhere. It is absolutely forbidden to light a fire anywhere on or around the property. Life on the farm The farm is a wonderful discovery area for children but also a place full of danger. For their safety, never let young children walk near animals without supervision. For questions of cohabitation with the flock and our dogs, pets are not allowed. Before leaving The following points are to be verified, thank you. - stove and oven cleaned. - clean and tidy dishes. - garbage bin emptied and cleaned. - compost bin emptied and cleaned. - beds: sheets and duvets folded, placed on the beds. - toilet: bowl emptied into the compost and cleaned - general cleaning: swept floor In any case, the immediate surroundings are put in order, do not leave cigarette butts, various papers ... Bris: Any breakage of which you will be responsible will be charged to you in surplus. We are aware that it is not very pleasant to be told what seems obvious to the good maintenance of a place of life, unfortunately from experience we know that it is sometimes necessary to remember. We simply ask you to manage the micro-house " in good father ", expression obsolete today but that we find pretty.
