

# Rules of good conduct

For the good course of your stay, and that of the persons who will succeed you, we thank you in advance to not smoke inside the tiny-house, to be attentive when you smoke outside, and to respect the few points below.



## Use of the premises

Remove your shoes before entering the tiny-house.

## Use of the dry toilet :

After each visit to the toilet, please deposit a sufficient quantity of sawdust to cover all the liquid as well as the feces but no need to put too much !

When the bucket is full, transport it to the compost and empty the bucket.

After emptying, the bucket is cleaned with water then put back in the toilet.

Sawdust bags are available behind the dry toilet.



## Use of the solar shower :



As soon as possible, place the solar shower, previously filled with cold water (fill 2/3 full to avoid tearing the bag), flat on the black support located behind the tiny-house.

The sun will now do the rest.

If the weather is too cloudy, heat water on the stove in the kettle and mix it with cold water to the temperature you want.

A bucket is available in the shower.



## Waste sorting and compost :

A recycling bin is available. You will be able to empty it into our recycling bin when you leave. An explanatory leaflet concerning recyclable materials is available.

Please read it because we do not like to have to sort your waste in the garbage container after your departure ...



## Compost :

In the countryside it is easy to make compost.

We provide a compost bin on the kitchen counter.

When it is full, empty it into the compost behind the dry toilet.

Thank you for using the wooden plank when preparing food.



## Wood stove

Ask us for a hand if you are not familiar with wood stoves.

There is a fire extinguisher above the stove. **Be careful !**



## Water :

When you arrive, we will have prepared two water tanks, one of 100 liters and another one of 20 liters. If you need more water, we will show you where to fill the small tank.

## Life on the farm :

The farm is a wonderful place of discovery for children but also a place full of danger. For their safety, never let your young children walk near animals without supervision.

For cohabitation with the herd and our dog, pets are not allowed.



In the dry season, fire hazards are everywhere.

It is **absolutely forbidden to light a fire** anywhere on or around the property.

Please refrain from smoking in the forest during dry periods.

Sleeping bags available :  
\$ 20 per bag for the time of the stay.



Cleaning your laundry :

It is possible to wash and dry your laundry upon request.

\$ 20 per laundry basket.

## Before leaving :



The following points are to be respected imperatively in order to put the tiny-house back in the state in which you found it :



- Stove and oven cleaned.
- Crockery cleaned and tidied up.
- Trash can emptied and cleaned.
- Compost garbage can emptied and cleaned.
- Beds: sleeping bags and blankets folded and put on the beds.
- Used towels placed in the laundry basket.
- Toilet: **compost garbage can emptied and cleaned.**
- General cleaning: swept floor.



In all cases, the immediate surroundings are put back in order, do not leave cigarettes butts, papers...

We are aware that it is not very pleasant to be told what seems obvious.

Unfortunately through experience we know that it is far too often necessary to provide reminders.

We simply ask you to manage the tiny-house "as a good family man", an outdated expression nowadays but one which we find pretty.
